We fly... So they Can't

ou've heard us talk about the number of children we were burying each and every week who succumbed to malaria... a ridiculous, yet deadly parasite that much of the world has been rid of for many years. In our own footprint around Light Village, we've seen the numbers go from 3-5 deaths of infants EVERY. SINGLE. WEEK. to ZERO for the past 9 years because of education and quick treatment...but the rest of Uganda, and most of Africa really, is still sadly losing little ones from 0-5 years in horrific numbers. And it doesn't only impact the children. Adults lose productivity, money and their lives. We are honored to be partnering with the USF College of Public Health, and Dr. Benjamin Jacobs, to implement a malaria reduction scheme which identifies



and eradicates the breeding areas of malaria-producing anopheles mosquitoes in an attempt to reduce the infection of all people. Dr. Jacobs has developed the drone program, "**Seek & Destroy**" that we will be putting to work the second quarter of 2023 in the villages all around Light Village! This is a GIANT prayer come true!

One Life for \$1- We estimate that for every dollar we invest in this <u>life-saving</u> initiative, one case of malaria will be prevented! We have etched out a budget from our general funds to start this important work and we are believing grants and donations will help carry this program throughout the rest of Uganda... and then... <u>the world!</u> We invite and encourage everyone to be part of this **HISTORIC CAMPAIGN TO FINALLY PUT AN ABSOLUTE END TO THE COUNTLESS TRAGIC NUMBER OF DEATHS WORLD-WIDE**.

Hitting the ground in Uganda post COVID - We look back over the months we first arrived back in Uganda after COVID kept us away for over a year, and every day we have felt like we're 'God's favorite children'...I mean, He makes us all feel that way, doesn't He? He put everything in place to get the millhouse built, the best milling machines, the millhouse

open...and then brought mamas from far and wide to have their harvest milled for dinner, collect their water, share their lives with us a bit and carry-on home with more time to work in their gardens and care for their families. When electric to the village shrunk to 2-3 days a week, He made a way through your generosity to purchase a <u>BIG</u>, and I mean <u>BIG</u> generator to keep things working!





Medical Diagnostics - He made the way for a crazy expensive (and exquisite) 3-D, full color ultrasound machine that we purchased in January to achieve the best diagnostics for miles around. If only you could see the mamas faces when they hear the heartbeat of their baby for the first time, see their baby's face and watch as tiny arms and legs are kicking; when they, for the first time, connect that this little human is growing right inside them! Talking them into prenatal care and better nutrition has become much easier thanks to this magical machine!

And it doesn't just work for new moms - This machine has been a lifesaver to many, including a man with his appendix about to burst and quickly receiving emergency surgery; it's found enlarged spleens, abnormal growths, issues with blood flow, abdominal concerns, and sadly many times too late, tumors that have proven to be later stage cancers.

Our ultrasound has worked wonders and alongside our high-power microscope donated by another ministry leaving Uganda, we're already able to diagnose more health concerns before patients are past the point of no return. Imagine how exciting this will be in our new **Sean Gilbert Memorial Medical Center** due to open early 2023!

How's that going, you ask? So, So <u>Incredibly well!</u> With a crew of 40 construction workers, we are nearly finished with the outside of the building, and a good deal of the inside construction! We expanded our welding crew, who fabricated every single roofing truss (not like we have a 'construction store' to go to and buy ready made anything!) and then got them all up...while our roofing team was on standby waiting for 30 million shillings (about \$8,000) worth of iron sheets to arrive! Shortages in everything (like the states) put us a bit behind schedule. The roof is now complete and gorgeous! And now they're working on fabricating every single door and window in this amazing building! This unbelievably magnificent, 4000 sq. ft. medical center is completely life-changing for eastern



Uganda! With exam rooms, ultrasound room, fantastic lab, consultation rooms, pharmacy, and training center we feel so confident that YOU will be impacting more lives than any of us ever imagined! How can we thank YOU enough?



Little Lights – We are in full swing, meeting at Light Village every Saturday under the tutelage of our passionately faithful coordinator, Sam Waburoko. We wish you could see these precious kids up close and personal! They LOVE being at the LV CAMPUS... they're learning English, and more importantly how to read and write. Most of the kids even though they are 12 years and older are in government schools and have not been taught reading and writing. For Christmas they were each gifted their very own book of their choice and it was the sweetest day! Wait until you see their Christmas video to YOU! Lessons from the Bible are still their favorite and Teacher Rose incorporates the Word in her weekly teaching with the kids. Leadership training has been added to their curriculum and they are learning all aspects of beekeeping from constructing hives and gathering honey to selling honey and investing back into their businesses! The students

are really gaining confidence and a newly found mindset of value and worth. They are grateful to YOU for their snacks and small meals when at Light Village!



Weekly Medical Clinics - We have had the pleasure (and sometimes heartbreak) of serving over **4,500** patients this year. YOU have invested more than **\$45,000** in services and medications for our patients. They are JOYFUL in sharing the load a bit with a small payment for their care of about \$2.

Kids in nutrition programs – Food insecurity and high prices everywhere has had a BIG impact on the children...especially the population of children with Cerebral Palsy, Sickle Cell and HIV/Aids. That's typically because children that have such infirmaries are often fed whatever is left after the healthy family members eat. Sad, and a reality. We've been working with a num-

ber of families with malnourished children, but these three are close to home: Patience, 17...started out at 39 lbs., and is now at 55; Bridget is 13 years old and weighs about 50 lbs., and Hussein is 14 and weighs only 20 lbs. We're starting from scratch with him.



Watercarts and Empowerment Initiatives - We have graduated 90 students this year who we're believing will use their new knowledge in farming techniques to carry them through this extended hunger season. **You invested \$11,250!**

You have helped to:

- Plant two new churches
- Train 76 students in Ebola, HIV/Aids, Malaria and other diseases mitigation, treatment & protocols
- Provide 30 students Literacy classes, two days a week, plus Math and Business
- Provide 6 scholarships to well deserving students
- Celebrate 207 new believers in the church
- Serve over 4,000 people at "Cabrera's Ezekiel Millhouse" AND purchase a giant generator for \$26,000 to keep our families eating!
- Add new programs and partnerships; Justice for widows and orphans in land disputes, and continued training with the Statehouse Vocational Training Hub for the most vulnerable young adults in rural areas.
